### 1. Hungary – Nyíregyháza

- **Film Club:** Participating students watched the series “*Nature is Speaking*”, which highlights the connection between nature and human life.
- **Impacts of Climate Change:** Students viewed the short film “*Climate Change: The Impact on Us*”, which emphasizes the dangers of global warming.
- **Measuring the Ecological Footprint:** Students completed a questionnaire on their ecological footprint and presented the results.

### 2. Italy – Sciacca

- **Preparatory Activities:** The school prepared for the reception of international partners, organizing accommodation, transportation, and the academic program.
- **Sustainability Workshops:** Students completed a questionnaire on their ecological footprint and worked in groups on the theme “*The History of Sustainability*”.
- **Excursions:** Students visited Lago Arancio, a thermal bath in Montevago, and the UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Valley of the Temples.

### 3. Slovakia – Zlaté Moravce

- **Preparatory Meeting:** A parents’ evening was held regarding the trip to Sicily.
- **CO<sub>2</sub> Footprint Analysis:** Teachers and students completed a questionnaire on their CO<sub>2</sub> footprint, which was subsequently analyzed.
- **Energoland Visit:** An educational trip to the interactive educational center Energoland in Mochovce was organized.

### 4. Greece – Larissa

- **Environmental Projects:** The school collaborated with the City of Larissa to green the schoolyard with plants and trees.
- **E-Waste Collection:** Students launched an environmental campaign for the recycling of light bulbs and electronic waste.
- **Hike along the Pinios River:** On the occasion of National Sports Day, students and teachers went on a hike along the river.
- **Visit to an Eco-Village:** Teachers, students, and parents attended an open day in a sustainable village to learn about sustainable lifestyles.

The sustainability programs continue to be a great success at the partner schools. The active participation of students and teachers contributes to the development of environmentally conscious thinking, which remains sustainable and eco-friendly in the long term.
