



We are pleased to share with you in this final newsletter the latest news from our project, which also marks an important milestone in our joint work.

During the past period, all partner institutions – the Hungarian, Slovak, Greek, and Italian schools – actively worked on the project’s dissemination tasks. Within this framework, each school has created its own TikTok videos and podcasts showcasing the experiences, results, and best practices gathered throughout the project. These modern, youth-oriented formats provide an opportunity to make the message of sustainability accessible to a wider audience.



The Greek partner school successfully held its multiplier event in Larissa at the end of January. During the event, the project results, sustainable learning environments, and products developed by students and teachers were presented.

On January 23, 2026, the partner school in Larissa successfully organized the project’s final dissemination event, providing a fitting conclusion to the Erasmus+ collaboration from February 2024 to January 2026. The aim of the event was to give a comprehensive overview of the project activities, the results of the international partnership, and the development of the participating students and teachers.

The program included detailed presentations of the subject-specific and learning activities conducted in the various countries, the jointly developed teaching materials, and the project outcomes. A particular emphasis was placed on the active involvement of the learners: students were not only participants but also active contributors to the project. In their presentations, they reflected on their experiences and personal development, particularly in the areas of teamwork, responsibility, intercultural communication, and environmentally conscious thinking.

A central element of the event was the presentation of the “sustainable green classroom,” which emerged as one of the most significant and tangible project outcomes. This innovative learning space supports education for sustainable development in the long term and provides room for interactive workshops, projects, and community activities.

The event saw broad participation: members of the local educational community, teachers from other schools, parents, and local decision-makers attended, further strengthening the societal embedding and visibility of the project. The event not only served to present the results but also provided a platform for exchanging experiences and initiating future collaborations.
